Matt 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, <u>she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.</u>	Jesus conceived by the Holy Ghost.
Matt 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, <u>the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream</u> , saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is <u>conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.</u>	Angel of the LORD -> Joseph in a dream. To take Mary as wife.
Matt 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance. but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: <u>he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:</u>	Jesus will baptise with the Holy Ghost and with fire.

Mark 1:10-12 <sup>10</sup> And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: <sup>11</sup> And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. <sup>12</sup> And immediately the spirit driveth him into the wilderness.	Jesus baptised. Spirit like a dove descending on Him. By Spirit into wilderness.
Mark 3:29 But he that shall <u>blaspheme against the Holy Ghost</u> hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation.	Blasphemy against Holy Ghost not forgiven.

Luke 1:15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the <b>Holy Ghost</b> , even from his mother's womb. (Luke 1:13-17)	John the Baptist filled with Holy Ghost -> mother's womb.

The Holy Spirit verses in the Bible:

<p>LUKE:</p> <p>Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, <u>The Holy Ghost</u> shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.</p> <p>Luke 1:40-45 <sup>40</sup> And entered into the house of Zacharias, and saluted Elisabeth. <sup>41</sup> And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, <u>the babe leaped in her womb</u>; and <u>Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost</u>: <sup>42</sup> And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. <sup>43</sup> And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? <sup>44</sup> For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy. <sup>45</sup> And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.</p> <p>Luke 1:67-79 <sup>67</sup> And his father Zacharias was <u>filled with the Holy Ghost</u>, and prophesied, saying, <sup>68</sup> Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, <sup>69</sup> And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; <sup>70</sup> As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began: <sup>71</sup> That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; <sup>72</sup> To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant; <sup>73</sup> The oath which he sware to our father Abraham, <sup>74</sup> That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, <sup>75</sup> In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life. <sup>76</sup> And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways; <sup>77</sup> To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins, <sup>78</sup> Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us, <sup>79</sup> To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.</p> <p>Luke 2:25-26 <sup>25</sup> And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: <u>and the Holy Ghost was upon him</u>. <sup>26</sup> And <u>it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost</u>, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he <u>came by the Spirit</u> into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, (Luke 2:25-32)</p> <p>Luke 3:16 John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: <u>he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire</u>:</p> <p>Luke 3:22 And <u>the Holy Ghost</u> descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.</p> <p>Luke 4:1 And <u>Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost</u> returned from Jordan, and was led by <u>the Spirit</u> into the wilderness,</p> <p>Luke 4:14 And Jesus returned <u>in the power of the Spirit</u> into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.</p> <p>Luke 4:17-21 <sup>17</sup> And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written, <sup>18</sup> <u>The Spirit of the Lord is upon me</u>, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, <sup>19</sup> To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. <sup>20</sup> And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. <sup>21</sup> And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.</p> <p>Luke 12:10-12 <sup>10</sup> And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against <u>the Holy Ghost</u> it shall not be forgiven. <sup>11</sup> And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how</p>	<p>By Holy Ghost Mary with child.</p> <p>Mary visits Elisabeth. At Mary's greeting Elisabeth filled with Holy Ghost.</p> <p>Zacharias filled with the Holy Ghost and prophesied saying....</p> <p>Simeon, just and devout, Holy Ghost was upon him. <p>LUKE:  or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: <sup>12</sup> For <u>the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.</u></p>	<p>When persecuted, the Holy Ghost will teach and give words to say.</p>
<p>JOHN:  John 1:32-33 <sup>32</sup> And John bare record, saying, I saw <u>the Spirit</u> descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. <sup>33</sup> And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see <u>the Spirit</u> descending, and remaining on him, the same is <u>he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.</u></p> <p>John 3:5-8 <sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of <u>the Spirit</u>, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. <sup>6</sup> That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which <u>is born of the Spirit is spirit.</u> <sup>7</sup> Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. <sup>8</sup> The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: <u>so is every one that is born of the Spirit.</u></p> <p>John 3:34 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not <u>the Spirit</u> by measure unto him.</p> <p>John 4:23-24 <sup>23</sup> But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. <sup>24</sup> <u>God is a Spirit:</u> and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.</p> <p>John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: <u>the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.</u></p> <p>John 7:38-39 <sup>38</sup> He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. <sup>39</sup> (But this spake he of <u>the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.</u>)</p> <p>John 14:16-21 <sup>16</sup> And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another <u>Comforter</u>, that he may abide with you for ever;  <sup>17</sup> Even the <u>Spirit of truth</u>; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. <sup>18</sup> I will not leave you comfortless: <u>I will come to you.</u> <sup>19</sup> Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.  <sup>20</sup> At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. <sup>21</sup> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.</p> <p>John 14:22-26 <sup>22</sup> Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. <sup>24</sup> He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me. <sup>25</sup> These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you. <sup>26</sup> But the <u>Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost</u>, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.</p> <p>John 15:26 But when <u>the Comforter</u> is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even <u>the Spirit of truth</u>, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:</p>	<p>At Jesus' baptism, John saw the Spirit like a dove on Jesus. Jesus will baptise with the Holy Ghost.</p> <p>A man must be born of water and of the Spirit.  Born of flesh = flesh.  Born of the Spirit = spirit.</p> <p>Jesus speaks the words of God given by the Spirit.</p> <p>God is a Spirit. True worshippers must worship Him in spirit &amp; truth.</p> <p>Jesus' words are spirit and life.</p> <p>Those who believe in Jesus will receive the Spirit. -&gt; Rivers of living water flow out of belly.</p> <p>Comforter – abide with you for ever.  The Spirit of truth – will dwell with you and be in you.  Jesus says "I will come to you".  Jesus in the Father.  We in Jesus &amp; Jesus in us.  Loves Jesus -&gt; has commandments &amp; keeps them.  Jesus says "I will manifest myself to him"  Loves Jesus – keep His words -&gt; Father &amp; Jesus will abide with him.  Jesus speaks the Father's words.  The Father sends the Comforter, is the Holy Ghost, in Jesus name.  He will teach all things, bring all things Jesus said to remembrance.</p> <p>Father sends the Comforter, the Spirit of truth. Will testify Jesus.</p>

The Holy Spirit verses in the Bible:

<p><b>JOHN:</b></p> <p>John 16:7-16 <sup>7</sup> Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, <u>the Comforter</u> will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. <sup>8</sup> And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: <sup>9</sup> Of sin, because they believe not on me; <sup>10</sup> Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; <sup>11</sup> Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.</p> <p><sup>12</sup> I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. <sup>13</sup> Howbeit when he, <u>the Spirit of truth</u>, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. <sup>14</sup> He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. <sup>15</sup> All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you. <sup>16</sup> A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.</p> <p>John 20:21-22 <sup>21</sup> Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you. <sup>22</sup> And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, <u>Receive ye the Holy Ghost:</u></p>	<p>The Comforter will come: Will reprove the world of sin, &amp; of righteousness, &amp; of judgment. Sin – world believes not in Jesus Righteousness - Jesus goes to Father. Judgment – prince of world is judged. The Spirit of truth: Will guide into all truth. Will only speak &amp; show things He hears from Jesus.</p> <p>After Jesus risen – breathed the Holy Ghost on His disciples.</p>

<p><b>ACTS:</b></p> <p>Acts 1:1-5 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, <sup>2</sup> Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through <u>the Holy Ghost</u> had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen: <sup>3</sup> To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God: <sup>4</sup> And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. <sup>5</sup> For John truly baptized with water; <u>but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.</u></p> <p>Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that <u>the Holy Ghost is come upon you</u>: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.</p> <p>Acts 2:4-18 <sup>4</sup> And they were all <u>filled with the Holy Ghost</u>, and began to speak with <u>other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.</u> <sup>5</sup> And there were dwelling at Jerusalem <u>Jews, devout men, out of every nation</u> under heaven. <sup>6</sup> Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that <u>every man heard them speak in his own language.</u> <sup>7</sup> And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans?</p> <p><sup>8</sup> And how <u>hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?</u> <sup>9</sup> Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, <sup>10</sup> Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, <sup>11</sup> Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in <u>our tongues the wonderful works of God.</u> <sup>12</sup> And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this? <sup>13</sup> <u>Others mocking said,</u> These men are full of new wine. <sup>14</sup> But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: <sup>15</sup> <u>For these are not drunken, as ye suppose,</u> seeing it is but the third hour of the day. <sup>16</sup> But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; <sup>17</sup> And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith <u>God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh:</u> and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: <sup>18</sup> And on my servants and on my handmaidens <u>I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:</u></p> <p>Acts 2:32-33 <sup>32</sup> This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. <sup>33</sup> Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and <u>having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.</u></p>	<p>Jesus gave commandments unto the apostles by the Holy Ghost. Wait for the promise of the Father: They will be baptized with the Holy Ghost.</p> <p>Will receive power – Holy Ghost come upon you – will be witnesses in all the world.</p> <p>Filled with the Holy Ghost. Speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave utterance. Jews, devout men out of every nation. Every man heard in his own language, in his own tongue wherein he was born. -&gt; TONGUES=LANGUAGES Hear wonderful works of God. Others mocking said they were drunk. <p>Acts 2:37-38 <sup>37</sup> Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? <sup>38</sup> Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive <u>the gift of the Holy Ghost.</u></p>	<p>Peter: Repent &amp; be baptised in the name of Jesus Christ for sins. Receive gift of the Holy Ghost.</p>
<p>Acts 4:7-12 <sup>7</sup> And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?  <sup>8</sup> Then Peter, <u>filled with the Holy Ghost,</u> said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, <sup>9</sup> If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; <sup>10</sup> Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that <u>by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth,</u> whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. <sup>11</sup> This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. <sup>12</sup> Neither is there salvation in any other: <u>for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.</u></p>	<p>Peter: Filled with the Holy Ghost. Preaching Jesus. Man made whole by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. No other name under heaven whereby we must be saved.</p>
<p>Acts 4:24-33 <sup>24</sup> And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is: <sup>25</sup> Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? <sup>26</sup> The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ. <sup>27</sup> For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, <sup>28</sup> For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. <sup>29</sup> <u>And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,</u> <sup>30</sup> <u>By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.</u> <sup>31</sup> And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all <u>filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.</u> <sup>32</sup> And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common. <sup>33</sup> <u>And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.</u></p>	<p>All praising God &amp; lifting up their voice to God asking, praying: For boldness to speak God's word. For God's hand to heal. For signs &amp; wonders to be done in Jesus name. Prayed &amp; place shaken where they assembled. All filled with the Holy Ghost. Spoke the word of God with boldness. Apostles with great power witnessed the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. Great grace upon them all.</p>
<p>Acts 5:1-10 Ananias and Sapphira            Acts 5:3-4 <sup>3</sup> But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to <u>lie to the Holy Ghost,</u> and to keep back part of the price of the land? <sup>4</sup> Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? <u>thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.</u>            Acts 5:9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt <u>the Spirit of the Lord?</u> behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out.</p>	<p>Ananias:            Lied to the Holy Spirit. Lied to God. Therefore the Holy Ghost = God             Sapphira:            Tempt the Spirit of the Lord.</p>
<p>Acts 5:28-32 <sup>28</sup> Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not <u>teach in this name?</u> and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with <u>your doctrine,</u> and intend to bring this man's blood upon us. <sup>29</sup> <u>Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.</u> <sup>30</sup> The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. <sup>31</sup> Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. <sup>32</sup> <u>And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.</u></p>	<p>Obey God rather than men. Peter &amp; apostles witnesses of Jesus. God gives the Holy Ghost to them that obey him.</p>

The Holy Spirit verses in the Bible:

<p>ROMANS:</p> <p>Rom 8:1-39</p> <p>There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, <u>who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.</u> <sup>2</sup> For the <u>law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus</u> hath made me free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup> For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: <sup>4</sup> That <u>the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us,</u> who walk not after the flesh, <u>but after the Spirit.</u> <sup>5</sup> For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; <u>but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.</u> <sup>6</sup> For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. <sup>7</sup> Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. <sup>8</sup> So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. <sup>9</sup> But ye are not in the flesh, but in <u>the Spirit,</u> if so be that <u>the Spirit of God dwell in you.</u> Now if any man have not the <u>Spirit of Christ,</u> he is none of his. <sup>10</sup> And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but <u>the Spirit is life because of righteousness.</u> <sup>11</sup> But if <u>the Spirit</u> of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also <u>quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.</u> <sup>12</sup> Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. <sup>13</sup> For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through <u>the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.</u> <sup>14</sup> For as many as are <u>led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.</u> <sup>15</sup> For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received <u>the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.</u> <sup>16</sup> <u>The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:</u> <sup>17</sup> And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. <sup>18</sup> For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. <sup>19</sup> For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. <sup>20</sup> For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope, <sup>21</sup> Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. <sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. <sup>23</sup> And not only they, but ourselves also, <u>which have the firstfruits of the Spirit,</u> even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. <sup>24</sup> For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. <sup>26</sup> Likewise <u>the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities:</u> for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but <u>the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.</u> <sup>27</sup> And <u>he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit,</u> because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.</p> <p><sup>28</sup> And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. <sup>29</sup> For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. <sup>30</sup> Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. <sup>31</sup> What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? <sup>33</sup> Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. <sup>34</sup> Who is he that condemneth?
