GOD WANTS ALL MEN TO BE SAVED:

All men to be saved:

- John 1:7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that <u>all men through him</u> <u>might believe</u>.
- John 1:9 ⁹ That was the true Light, which lighteth <u>every man</u> that cometh into the world.
- 1 Tim 2:1-6

 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for <u>all men</u>; ² For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. ³ For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; ⁴ Who will have <u>all men</u> to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. ⁵ For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, <u>the man Christ</u>
 Jesus; ⁶ Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.
- 1 Tim 4:10 ¹⁰ For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is <u>the Saviour of all men</u>, specially of those that believe.
- Rom 5:18 ¹⁸Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one <u>the free gift came upon all men</u> unto justification of life.
- Rom 10:13 ¹³ For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- ⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but <u>that all should come to repentance</u>.
- John 5:22-24 ²² For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: ²³ That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. ²⁴ Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
- John 3:16

 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- John 12:32 ³² And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.
- Acts 17:30-31 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth <u>all men every where</u>
 <u>to repent</u>: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in
 righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance
 unto allmen, in that he hath raised him from the dead.
- Tit 2:11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to <u>all men</u>,
- Rev 22:17 ¹⁷ And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

- Heb 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death <u>for every man</u>.
- Luke 2:10-11 ¹⁰ And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to <u>all people</u>. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

- John 6:40 ⁴⁰ And this is the will of him that sent me, that <u>every one</u> which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- Rom 8:32 ³² He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for <u>us all</u>, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- Is 53:5-6

 But he was wounded for <u>our transgressions</u>, he was bruised for <u>our iniquities</u>: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes <u>we are healed</u>. ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and <u>the LORD hath laid</u> on him the iniquity of us all.
