

5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until <u>the thousand years</u> were finished. This is the **first resurrection**. John saw the souls of them that were:

- beheaded for the witness of Jesus
- for the word of God

Those that did not:

- worship the beast, neither his image
- receive his mark in their forehead /hands

They lived and reigned with Christ for <u>a 1,000 years</u>

Rest of the <u>dead</u> did not live until <u>the 1,000 years</u> is finished.

THE THOUSAND YEAR REIGN OF CHRIST THE MILLENNIUM




Rev 20:5 ⁵ But the rest of the dead lived not again until **the 1,000 years** were finished. This is the first resurrection.



How does THE 1,000 YEAR REIGN OF CHRIST fit in with John's vision in **Revelation 8-11** and **Revelation 16?**






How does **1,000 YEAR** REIGN OF CHRIST fit on the timeline?

1 Cor 15:20-26 ²⁰ But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. ²¹ For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. ²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. ²³ But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming. ²⁴ Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

⁵ For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.
²⁶ The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.





How to figure out what OT verses apply to what period or event:

Wrath of God (poured out on the earth)

- The rivers and fountains of water will be 'dead'.
- Grass, trees and plants scorched with fire.
- Cities will have collapsed and burnt.
- The desolation of Jerusalem.
- Israel rejecting God.
- The remnant of the nation, Israel protected by God in the wilderness.
- Etc.

The Millennium (reign of Christ on earth)

Verses where:

- The sea and waters are living.
- The earth is prosperous, seeds growing, gardens established, yields it's increase and giving excellent fruit etc.
- The wilderness becoming like the garden of Eden.
- The mountains dripping with new wine & hills flowing with milk etc.
- The sun, moon and sea are mentioned.
- The restoration of the nation Israel and their coming back to God.
- Etc.

These verses must therefore be in the Millennium.

New Earth and New Heaven

Rev 21 & 22:

- No sea.
- No sun.
- No moon.
- No night.

3 Types of people that will live in the Millennium.

- Saints that are resurrected at the First Resurrection

 (which is at Jesus' 2nd coming and the rapture Session 1):
 All believers that ever lived. (1 Thess 3:13, Zech 14:4-5)
 They return to earth with Christ at the battle of Armageddon. (Rev 19:14)
 They have their new glorified and resurrected immortal bodies.
 They will not have a 'flesh and blood' body but a spiritual body. (1 Cor 15:42-52)
- Mortal men who are saved:

They got saved:

after the rapture

- during the time when the wrath of God is poured out on the earth
- > or during the Millennium.

• Mortal men who are NOT saved:

Not all men will believe and accept that Jesus is who He says He is.


Pre-Millennial View:

Based on a **literal interpretation** of the Bible.

Belief that Jesus will literally return to the earth before (pre-) the millennium which is the 1,000 year reign of Jesus on the earth.

Belief that Jesus Himself will rule over His kingdom on the earth.

Position in the first 4 centuries of the early church's existence.



Symbolic Interpretations of the Millennium.

Other interpretations which ignore:

- 1. Revelation 20:1-7
- 2. Major prophets: Isaiah to Daniel
- 3. Minor Prophets: Hosea to Malachi

Amillennial View:


Literally means no millennium.

Allegorical approach or symbolic approach to scripture.

Allegorical approach examples in Scripture :


- belief that "last days" does not mean "last days".
- belief that "Israel and Jerusalem" does not mean "Israel and Jerusalem"
- belief that the "1,000 years" does not mean a "1,000 years"

Started in the 4th century. View introduced by the catholic theologian Augustine. He was convinced that the 1,000 year kingdom would be between Jesus' 1st and 2nd coming. Jesus rules over a "spiritual kingdom" in the hearts of mankind.



Post-Millennial View:

Belief that we are currently in the 1,000 reign of Christ.
Belief that the gospel would spread throughout the earth. Things would get gradually better and better.
Eventually through the effect of the gospel, men would bring in the kingdom.
After a 1,000 year of man's continued improvement, Jesus would return.
View introduced by a 17th century Unitarian minister, Daniel Whitby.



A FEW QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER:

For those that believe in a symbolic/spiritual 1,000 years:

Is Satan currently bound for a '1,000 years'? (Rev 20:2-3)

Which is valid for believers today?

"Those that will live and reign with Christ a 1,000 years" are: (Rev 20:4)

- Those that will have part in the first resurrection
- They that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus and for the word of God.
- Which have not worshipped the beast, neither his image.
- Which have not received the beast's mark in their forehead or in their hand.

Those that will have part in the first resurrection will: (Rev 20:6)

- be priests of God and of Christ
- and shall reign with Him a 1,000 years.

Have we as believers experienced the first resurrection?

Can one ignore the all the evidence in the Bible supporting the Pre-Millennial view?




