⁹ Behold **the day of the LORD** cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. ¹⁰ For **the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine.** ¹¹ And I

2 Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.”

He is the first and the last. (v11, v17, Rev 2:8, Rev 22:13)

He has the keys of hell and of death. (v18)

He is the Lion of the tribe of Juda. (Rev 5:5)

He is the Lamb. (Rev 5:6,8,12,13, Rev 6:1,16, Rev 7:9,10,14,17, Rev 12:11, Rev 13:8, Rev 14:1,4,10, Rev 15:3, Rev 17:14, Rev 19:7,9, Rev 21:9,14,22,23,27)

He is the King of Kings & the Lord of Lords. (Rev 17:14, Rev 19:16)

He is the root and the offspring of David. (Rev 5:5, Rev 22:16)

What vision did John see?

The Son of man in the midst of 7 golden candlesticks



Clothed with garment down to the foot with a golden girdle(v13).

Head and hair white like wool (snow). (v14)

Eyes were as flame of fire. (v14)

Feet like fine brass like in burning furnace. (v15)

Voice as sound of many waters. (v15)

Right hand seven stars. (v15)

Mouth a sharp two-edged sword. (v16)

Countenance was as the sun shining in his strength. (v16)

Revelation 4:

- **A door was opened in heaven**
- **The Throne in Heaven**
- **Worship to God the Father – on the Throne**

A door was opened in heaven: (Rev 4)

Rev 4:1

“After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, **and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.**”

Show thee things which must be hereafter.



The Throne in Heaven: (Rev 4)

One sat on the throne, like a jasper & a sardine stone. (v3)

A rainbow surrounds the throne and it looks like an emerald. (v3)

Round about the throne - 24 elders sitting on 24 seats. (v4)

24 elders clothed in white robes, on their heads crowns of gold. (v4)

From out of the throne - Lightnings, thunderings and voices. (v5)

7 lamps of fire burning before the throne = 7 Spirits of God. (v5)

Before the throne - Sea of glass, like crystal. (v6)

In the midst & round about the throne:

4 beasts: 1st like a lion

2nd like a calf

3rd had face of man

4th like a flying eagle. (v6 & v7)

4 beasts had each 6 wings, full of eyes within. (v8)



Worship to God the Father – on the Throne: (Rev 4)

4 Beasts (rest not day and night) saying:

Rev 4:8b

“Holy, holy, holy, LORD God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.”



Worship to God the Father – on the Throne: (Rev 4)

24 Elders (Fall down & cast their crowns before him that sat on the throne)

Rev 4:11

“Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.”



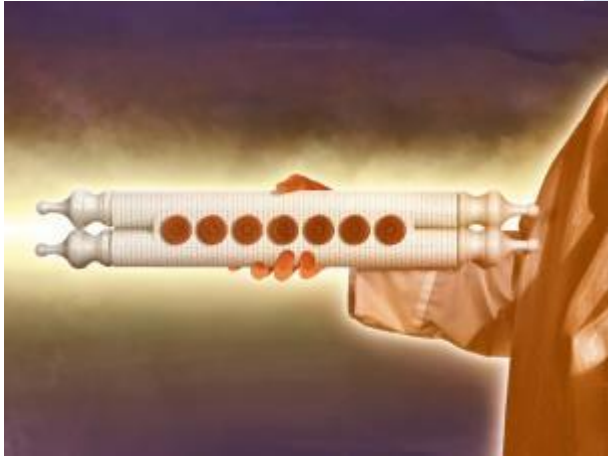
Revelation 5:

- **Who is worthy to open the seven seals?**
- **Worship to The Lamb who is worthy to open the book**

In the right hand of God the Father is a book/scroll sealed with 7 seals: (Rev 5:1)

Rev 5:2b Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

The Lamb (Jesus) is worthy to open the book.



Rev 5:5-6

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.



Worship to The Lamb who is worthy to open the book (Rev 5)

4 Beasts & 24 Elders (fall down before the Lamb, each with a harp & golden vial - prayers of the saints). Sung a new song:



Rev 5:9-10

“Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.”

Worship to The Lamb who is worthy to open the book (Rev 5)

Angels (10,000 x 10,000 & 1,000 1,000's) & 4 Beasts and 24 Elders. Saying with a loud voice:

Rev 5:12

“Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing”



Worship to The Lamb who is worthy to open the book (Rev 5)

Every creature in heaven,
on earth,
under the earth,
in the sea saying:

Rev 5:13

“Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.”

End session 1: - A few additional notes:

2 Tim 3:16-17

¹⁶All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: ¹⁷That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

- Our approach is Scripture (KJV) based, not following any particular teaching/pastor.
