When the THOUSAND years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of prison. Shall go out and deceive the nations **Gog and Magog**. (Rev 20:7-8)

> To gather them to battle. The number as the sand of the sea. (Rev 20:8)

REVELATION 20:7-10

Rev 20:7-8 ⁷ And when the 1,000 years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, ⁸ And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, **Gog, and Magog**, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

Went up on the breadth of the earth. Compassed the camp of the saints, the beloved city. (Rev 20:9)

Fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. (Rev 20:9)

The devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire. (Rev 20:10)

Rev 20:9 ⁹ And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

² Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog³ And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Gog,..... ⁴ And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of armour, even a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:.....⁶: and many people with thee.....⁸ After many days thou shalt be visited: in **the latter years** thou shalt come **into the land that is brought** back from the sword, and is gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them. ⁹ Thou shalt ascend and come like a storm, thou shalt be like a cloud to cover the land, thou, and all thy bands, and many people with thee......¹¹ And thou shalt say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates, ¹² To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn thine hand upon the desolate places that are now inhabited, and upon the people that are gathered out of the nations, which have gotten cattle and goods, that dwell in the midst of the land.

Timing: In the latter days (v8)

<u>Gog and Magog:</u> Against Gog, the land of Magog. (v2-v3) All thine army. (v4) Many people with thee. (v6, v9)

Israel:

Gathered out of many people. (v8) Against the mountains of Israel. (v8) Brought forth out of the nations. (v8, v12) Dwell in the midst of the land. (v12)

Within Israel: They shall dwell safely all of them. (v8,v11) Land of unwalled villages. (v11) Them that are at rest. (v11) Without walls & having neither bars nor gates. (v11)

Ez 38:14-23

¹⁴ Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely, shalt thou not know it? ¹⁵ And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, all of them riding upon horses, a great company, and a mighty army: ¹⁶ And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in the latter days, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes. ¹⁷ Thus saith the Lord GOD; Art thou he of whom I have spoken in old time by my servants the prophets of Israel, which prophesied in those days many years that I would bring thee against them? ¹⁸ And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face. ¹⁹ For in my jealousy and in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel;²¹ And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his

brother. ²² And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone. ²³ Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD. <u>Within Israel:</u> My people of Israel dwell safely. (v14)

The Lord GOD says:

My fury shall come up in my face. (v18) In my jealousy. (v18) In the fire of my wrath. (v18) I will magnify myself and sanctify myself. (v23) I will be known in the eyes of many nations. (v23) They shall know that I am LORD. (v23)

God's action:

Pestilence and with blood. (v22) An overflowing rain, and great hailstones. (v22) Fire and brimstone. (v22)

Ez 39:1-8

Therefore, thou son of man, prophesy against Gog, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal: ² And I will turn thee back, and leave but the sixth part of thee, and will cause thee to come up from the north parts, and will bring thee upon the mountains of Israel: ³ And I will smite thy bow out of thy left hand, and will cause thine arrows to fall out of thy right hand. ⁴ Thou shalt fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou, and all thy bands, and the people that is with thee: I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and to the beasts of the field to be **devoured**. ⁵ Thou shalt fall upon the open field: for I have spoken it, saith the Lord GOD. ⁶ And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I am the LORD. ⁷ So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.⁸ Behold, it is come, and it is done, saith the Lord GOD; this is the day whereof I have spoken.

<u>Gog and Magog:</u> I am against thee, O Gog. (v1) All the people with thee. (v4)

Israel:

Upon the mountains of Israel. (v2, v4)

The Lord GOD says:

They shall know that I am the LORD. (v6) I will make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel. (v7) Heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel. (v7)

<u>God's action:</u> Will smite bow out of left hand, arrow out of right hand. (v3) Ravenous birds and beasts shall devour. (v4) Will send fire on Magog. (v6)

"It is done" says the Lord GOD; "this is the day whereof I have spoken". (v8)

Ez 39:9-16

⁹ And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years: ¹⁰ So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down any out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord GOD. ¹¹ And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will give unto Gog a place there of graves in **Israel**, the valley of the passengers on the east of the sea: and it shall stop the noses of the passengers: and there shall they bury Gog and all his multitude: and they shall call it The valley of Hamongog. ¹² And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land. ¹³ Yea, all the people of the land shall bury them; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be glorified, saith the Lord GOD. ¹⁴ And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to cleanse it: after the end of seven months shall they search. ¹⁵ And the passengers that pass through the land, when any seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.¹⁶ And also the name of the city shall be Hamonah. Thus shall they cleanse the land.

Gog and Magog:

Shall set on fire and burn the weapons. (v9, v10)Burn them with fire seven years. (v9)Gog buried in graves in Israel. (v11)Bury Gog and all his multitude. (v11)

Israel:

They that dwell in the cities of Israel. (v9)


Seven months shall the house of Israel be burying them. (v12) CLEANSE THE LAND. (v12, v16)


The Lord GOD says: A renown day that I shall be glorified. (v13)

The Battle of Armageddon vs the Battle of Gog and Magog

ARMAGEDDON

A place called in Hebrew, Armageddon. (Rev 16:16) The battle of that great day of God Almighty. (Rev 16:14) Great river Euphrates dried up. (Rev 16:12)

6th Vial – kings of the earth & the whole world gathered. (Rev 16:12-16)
 7th Trumpet - Kingdoms of this world = the kingdoms of Christ. (Rev 11:15)
 BEFORE the 1,000 year reign of Christ on earth (The Millennium).

The beast and the 10 kings (unbelievers) come against the Lamb. He is Lord of lords and King of kings and with him are the called, chosen and faithful. (Rev 17:12-14, Rev 19:11-21)

Jesus comes from heaven to earth on a white horse. (Rev 19:11) In his mouth is a sharp sword with which He smites the nations. (Rev 19:15) Remnant slain with the sword out of His mouth. (Rev 19:21) Believers (raptured) are the armies which were in heaven and come with Jesus to earth. (Rev 19:14, 1 Thess 3:13) Jerusalem spiritually called Sodom and Egypt. (Rev 11:8) Jerusalem – Walled. Not safe. With walls, bars, gates. (current physical state of Jerusalem) The beast and false prophet cast into the lake of fire. (Rev 19:20) Fowls come to eat the flesh of men at the supper of the great God. (Rev 19:17-21) After the battle the judgment seat of Christ. (Rev 11:18, Rev 20:4) Rewards for believers. Weapons – Iron and steel? (current way of making war) 'Flesh of horses' mentioned in Rev 19:18. No mention of burning weapons or burying men.

GOG AND MAGOG

Nations in the 4 quarters of the earth are Gog and Magog. To gather them together to battle. (Rev 20:8) At the mountains of Israel. (Ez 38:8, Ez 39:2,4)

After Satan has been loosed to deceive the nations. (Rev 20:1-8) AFTER the 1,000 year reign of Christ on earth (The Millennium).

The nations of Gog and Magog come against the saints and the beloved city. The saints are believers which have lived and reigned with Christ for the 1,000 years. (Rev 20:4,6,9) Fire comes down from God out of heaven & devoured them. (Rev 20:9) Pestilence, with blood, an overflowing rain, great hailstones, fire and brimstone. (Ez 38:22)


There are saints living in the beloved city, Jerusalem. The nations of Gog and Magog come against these saints. (Rev 20:9) Jerusalem the beloved city. (Rev 20:9) Jerusalem - Unwalled villages. At rest. Dwell safely. Without walls, bars, gates. (Ez 38:11,14) Satan (devil) cast into lake of fire (beast & false prophet are). (Rev 20:10) Ravenous birds of every sort and beasts of the field to devour the people of Gog and Magog. (Ez 39:4) After the battle the great white throne judgment. (Rev 20:11-13) Unbelievers (the 'dead') judged according to their works. Weapons – shields & bucklers, bows & arrows, hand staves and

spears. (Ez 39:9) Horses and horsemen. (Ez 38:4,15)

After battle 7 years burning weapons. 7 month burying men.(Ez 39:9-15)



What is the second death?

Rev 2:11¹¹ He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

Rev 20:6 ⁶ Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such **the second death** hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. **Rev 20:14** ¹⁴ And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is **the second death**.

Rev 21:8 ⁸ But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is **the second death**.




CHARACTERISTICS OF HELL and THE LAKE OF FIRE

Luke 16:23-24 ²³ And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments , and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. ²⁴ And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame ²⁶ And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot ; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence. ²⁷ Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house : ²⁸ For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. 
"HELL" and "THE LAKE OF FIRE" on the timeline:
